Dear Parents,

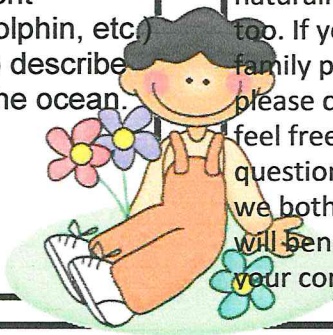

We are beginning our Sea Life Unit. We will be looking at a variety of sea life creatures found all over the world to see the different animals and plants found in them. During this unit, we will be focusing on learning the following:

- * Knows that ocean animals are found almost everywhere in the world; we will be studying about a variety of different animals- (whale, fish, octopus, dolphin, etc)
- * Students will need to be able to describe some of the animals that live in the ocean.

This is a good time to talk to your child about the animals that live in the ocean. You can point out different animals you see in your daily activities and how they are different from the animals that live in the ocean. As a Family, you might visit the library and/ or Aquarium to learn about the different animals that live in the oceans of the United States, but are naturally found in other areas of the world too. If you have any books, collections or family photos that may help us with our unit, please consider sharing them with us. Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions about your child's learning. When we both work together as a team, your child will benefit from the experience. What we are learning:

Language- letter recognition/ sounds, word building/ sentence building/ onset & rime/ compound words (individual lessons)

Math- quantity to number, 100 board, addition, subtraction, placed value, introduction to time (individual lessons)

Geography- The World

Science- Sea Life

Practical Life- Scrubbing seashells, hand-washing, water pouring, tying shoelaces, zipping (individual lessons)
